**Children's Society Box holders** – Rosemary would like to bring to your attention the need to sort out any old £1 coins you may have in your boxes and hand them into her. She will then able to deposit them. Many thanks for your help in this.

The following is an extract from the society's website

*"The new twelve-sided £1 coin is now in circulation and the old 'round' £1 coin will cease to be legal tender on 16 October 2017. Many of you have already contacted us regarding what this means for your networks of house box holders.*

*When new coins are introduced and old coins are phased out there is normally a 'grace period' when banks will accept both old and new coins. We are currently working with our banks to establish how long that grace period will be and what we can do to ensure we provide simple and clear instructions for our 5,000 dedicated house box co-ordinators and 95,000 box holders across the country.*

*We are awaiting clarification from the Bank of England on how long the old £1 coin will be accepted"*
