Minister Blessed are you, Lord our God, King of the universe. You make our darkness to be light.
For with you is the well of life and in your light shall we see light.

All hold up a candle. The president blesses the candles, saying

Lord God, the springing source of everlasting light, pour into the hearts of your faithful people the brilliance of your eternal splendour, that we, who by these kindling flames light up this temple to your glory, may have the darkness of our souls dispelled, and so be counted worthy to stand before you in that eternal city where you live and reign, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever.

Do you reject the devil and all rebellion against God?

Minister Do you repent of the sins that separate us from God and neighbour?

All **I repent of them.**

Minister Do you turn to Christ as Saviour?

All **I turn to Christ.**

Minister Do you submit to Christ as Lord?

All **I submit to Christ.**

Minister Do you come to Christ, the way, the truth and the life?

All **I come to Christ.**

Minister I ask you to profess the faith of the Church. Do you believe and trust in God the Father?

All **I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.**

Minister Do you believe and trust in his Son Jesus Christ?

All **I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again; he ascended into heaven, he is seated at the right hand of the Father, and he will come to judge the living and the dead.**
