Icon depicting the three angels (strangers) who visited Abraham and Sarah in the biblical narrative in Genesis 18: 1-15.

The chalice shaped bowl in the center has been interpreted as khora.

A Trinitarian interpretation sees the three strangers as the three persons of the Trinity.

The khora image has been identified with Mary.
