and rising to new life with him. Therefore I ask:

Do you reject the devil and all rebellion against God?

Minister Do you renounce the deceit and corruption of evil?

All **I renounce them.**

Minister Do you repent of the sins that separate us from God and neighbour?

All **I repent of them.**

Minister Do you turn to Christ as Saviour?

All **I turn to Christ.**

Minister Do you submit to Christ as Lord?

All **I submit to Christ.**

Minister Do you come to Christ, the way, the truth and the life?

All **I come to Christ.**

Minister I ask you to profess the faith of the Church. Do you believe and trust in God the Father?

All **I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.**

Minister Do you believe and trust in his Son Jesus Christ?

All **I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,

he descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again; he ascended into heaven, he is seated
